

REPORT OF THE 6TH MEETING OF ASEAN CHINA SENIOR OFFICIALS MEETING ON HEALTH DEVELOPMENT (6TH ASEAN CHINA SOMHD MEETING) 11 AUGUST 2016 BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

INTRODUCTION

1. The 6th Meeting of ASEAN China SOMHD Meeting was held in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam on 11 August 2016. The Meeting was chaired by Brunei Darussalam and China as the Co-Chair of the Meeting. The Meeting was attended by focal points and representatives from ten ASEAN Member States (AMS), China, and ASEAN Secretariat. Detail list of participants appears as **ANNEX 1.**

Dr. Tran Thi Giang Huong, Director General, International Cooperation Department, Ministry of Health, Viet Nam, as out-going Chair, reported to the Meeting the progress and achievement made for 2015-2016 during Viet Nam-China Chairmanship. 7. ASEAN Secretariat presented the progress on the ASEAN –China MOU on Health as signed in 2012. The Meeting further noted the activities under the Plan of Action of the ASEAN China MOU on Health. This focused on the prevention and control of communicable diseases, EID including pandemics; public health emergency response; prevention and control of NCDs; and capacity building for HRH. These will serve as basis for identifying areas of collaboration for 2016 – 2017. The presentation appears as **ANNEX 5**.

- 7.1 Updates on Implementation of Areas of Collaboration based on previous agreements and Endorsed Plan of Action of the ASEAN-China MOU on Health Cooperation
- 8. ASEAN Secretariat presented the continuing areas of collaboration under the ASEAN- MOU and the possible areas under the ASEAN Post-2015 Health Development Agenda. The Meeting noted the current collaboration with China specifically on the implementation of the ongoing ASEAN China MOU on Health. Presentation appears as **ANNEX 6.**
- 9. China presented updates on activities under the ASEAN- MOU which include 1) Prevention and control of communicable disease such as in HIV and AIDS, influenza training course, MDR TB in GMS countries, cross border program on malaria, TB HIV/ AID and plague; 2) Prevention and control on NCDs; 3) HR Development on epidemiology, disease prevention and control, MCH, health emergency, schistosomiasis and helminthiasis; 4) Traditional Medicine Development; 5) UHC and 6) Medical and Health Aid which entail building of hospitals. The Meeting noted these areas of collaboration. Presentation appears as **ANNEX 7.**

10. Meeting noted possible areas of collaboration with China as proposed by AMS. For China, the areas proposed to include, among others, capacity building on Traditional Medicine, food safety, epidemiology training and health care reform. Cluster approach in the identification of possible areas of collaboration was proposed. China acknowledged the proposals.

7.2 Identification of Priority Areas of Collaboration for 2016- 2017

- 11. The ASEAN Member States exchanged views with China on the proposed activities as presented in Agenda 7.1 agreed to streamline the proposed priorities for 2016-2017. The Meeting agreed on the following priority areas of collaboration for 2016 2017:
 - a. Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases (focus on GMS)
 - b. Public Health Emergency Response Mechanism and capacity for health impact of Natural Disasters
 - c. HRD development for Health
 - d. Traditional Medicine
 - Traditional medicine research guideline development
 - TM/CM forum in Philippines in 2017
 - e. Food safety and Rapid Alert System
