### Objective of workshop

AAAH is the regional network in Human Resource for Health (HRH), which has 17 member countries, 8 from South East Asia, and 9 from Western Pacific Region. The workshop was held in theme “Update progress and lessons on implementing the Global Strategy on HRH: Workforce 2030”.

### Result of workshop

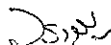
The goal of investment in HRH is for ensure achievement SDGs & UHC through availability, accessibility, acceptability, coverage and quality of the health workforce. The Global Strategy on HRH, Workforce 2030, composes of 4 objectives: 1. Accreditation mechanism to ensure qualified HRH, 2. Invest HRH in view of health labor market by concerning in international recruitment of health personnel/ HRH migration, 3. HRH governance mechanism, and 4. HRH data system for monitoring and planning on evidence. For this coming 2020, Thailand has been planned to achieve in the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> objective which including setting up HRH coordination unit, development of the united and efficiency digital HRH information system, accreditation of all health-related professions and increase coverages of hospital accreditation combines with 2P Safety policy.

### Advantage from workshop

This 4-day intensive workshop helped me more clarified in the HRH agenda. The experience from this workshop will be helpful for Thai team to do better job around this area.

### Policy recommendation for MOPH

Thailand has progressed a lot in all target milestones from the Global Strategy on HRH, however no objective is completely achieved at present. The important thing, which is one of the objectives, is to develop HRH governance mechanism. Although this topic has been discussed in MOPH already, commitment from high level policy makers will make the HRH coordinating unit really functioning.
