## Report on Training course for EPI provincial manager Lao PDR during 5<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> November,2018

#### At Health Promoting Hospital, Health Promotion Center 7<sup>th</sup> KhonKaen

#### Objectives

- 1. To capacity building of EPI provincial manager, Lao PDR
- 2. Improve communication for the communities participation
- 3. To change EPI experience between Thailand Lao PDR

#### Results of the training

We followed the lesson plan Training Course in Expanded Program of Immunization

For EPI provincial manager from Lao PDR which we modified from WHO modules and the Thai National Vaccine Institute. and also set the workshop during training by studying in well child clinic and field studying in Banphang district hospital, Nongbua sub district hospital. They learnt how to manage the vaccine storage and contingency plan from the Prevention and Control Disease Bureau 7<sup>th</sup> KhonKaen. Total course duration 2 weeks. For the 2<sup>st</sup> session we had 25 participants from 9 provinces. They were the physicians and the staffs who response to EPI in Lao PDR.

We found the result of training were:

- 1. The comparison scores of Pre-Post examination were 24.2 (44.0%) and 45.6 (82.9%) respectively from the full score 55 (100%). They had developed 46.9 %
- 2. The course evaluation, the average of satisfaction was 91.6 , the most satisfaction was the service of staffs 96.0%. The subordinately were the co-coordinating for training, the facilities during training and the opinion about training overview which was equity 95.2% . The suggestion were the lecture should be Thai language more than English. They ask for the longer period and let them more practice in clinic. Also the trainer should evaluate in their health station, Lao PDR later.
- 3. The evaluation of lecturers satisfaction at 93.0%. The ability to transfer knowledge and experience were clearly was the most at level 96.4%.
- 4. The analyzing of the different EPI management between Thailand Lao PDR. Actually we are similar of vaccines because of the diseases but the optional vaccines list in Thailand were regulated in Lao PDR and free of charge. Lao faced about the inefficiency of provider and the staff had many duties in the same time. They lacked of communication to the clients and then effected to the next appointments. They also had the obstacles about the geographic in addition the traditional and cultural. The advantages of attending the training are how to overcome these problems. They learnt to build health literacy for the communities and wonder of herd immunity problem. They plan to do in next step as follow:
  - 4.1 Set the target goal
  - 4.2 Team providers at setting and in the communities
  - 4.3 Set places to provide vaccination where are easy access
  - 4.4 Set enough budget for EPI management
  - 4.5 Calculation the enough vaccine and equipments
  - 4.6 Important and strict of cold chain system in every level of service
  - 4.7 Set report system in annual, trimester and month
  - 4.8 Empowerment staffs who response EPI management
  - 4.9 Seek for the target who lost vaccine and make coverage by accuracy report system

- 4.10 Give knowledge or health literacy during the services
- 4.11 The adverse events after vaccination should report immediately and investigate
- 4.12 Good communication and point to the benefits of vaccination
- 4.13 The knowledge of provider is important
- 4.14 The media relations were important

5 They had learnt about preparing for the immunization session from district and sub district hospital. They had to talk about the role of village health volunteers who seek for pregnant women and new born and follow them for vaccination. If they had migrated the report will show vaccine data as well.

#### Suggestion

- 1. Gain more training period and more providing practice in clinic for participants
- 2. The evaluation should be at health stations in Lao PDR after training 3 6 months.
